Supporting Youth Leaders across Oregon

This year marks the final year of Gray Family Foundation's initial investment in our Youth Leadership Initiative, which provided three-years of funding to 20 organizations across Oregon working to empower high-school age youth to use their leadership skills in the environmental sector. During phase one of our investment, we experienced the powerful impact of organizations that invest directly in youth leaders and amplify community



strengths to support a healthy and thriving Oregon. We are also proud of the shared learning and collaboration accomplished by our Youth Leadership Grantee Learning Cohort, co-led by Wallowa Resources and CAPACES Leadership Institute.
